[Dan Corrou, SJ](#), is a Jesuit scholastic in his second year of theology studies at Boston College School of Theology and Ministry. In 2014, he returned to the U.S. after working for three years with the Jesuits in the Middle East, responding to the influx of Syrian refugees who flooded Lebanon and the surrounding areas to escape violence.

Earlier this year, he spoke at a [Jesuit Connection](#) event, about how his time in a city far from home allowed him to connect deeply with Ignatius' calling to go where needs are greatest while always serving those on the peripheries.

"The center of my life must be on the margins," Dan said. "Wherever people are forgotten and pushed to the periphery, I must find my home. As a Jesuit, and as a person inspired by Ignatian spirituality, I am called to center myself on the periphery."
